## What Can I Sell at Auction?

The short answer is: nearly anything! Every day, bidders come to K-BID.com to look for vehicles, trailers, commercial and farm equipment, household goods, tools, construction materials, and more. That said, there are a few items that are prohibited from being sold on K-BID.com, as well as certain types of assets that are less popular on K-BID and may not meet seller expectations for value.

## Items <u>not</u> accepted by K-BID\*:

- Drop-down cribs, used car seats
- Alcohol (with rare exceptions)
- Used mattresses
- Pets/non-livestock animals
- Distasteful, offensive or risque items
- Gold plated "currency"

## Items that typically underperform:

- Clothing, shoes
- Some collectibles (dolls, Beanie Babies, NASCAR)
- Framed art reproductions/prints
- Glassware, including Depression glass
- Entertainment centers, pianos
- 1970s-1990s upholstered furniture
- Garage sale leftovers
